


**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING  
BETWEEN  
Brahman Samaj of North America

World Brahman Federation Canada**

At their first meeting on 28 March 2009, Brahman Samaj of North America (BSNA) and World Brahman Federation Canada (WBF Canada) affirmed their commitment for mutual cooperation. 


